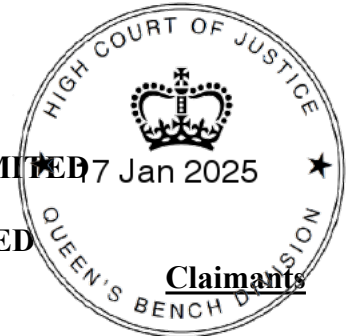

AND UPON the Court being satisfied, on the evidence and submissions before it as to circumstances and investigations made by or available to the Claimants, that the Claimants have thereby taken all practicable steps to notify the Defendants of the Application prior to the hearing pursuant to section 12(1) and (2) of the Human Rights Act 1998

AND UPON the Claimants undertaking to the Court hereafter to use its best endeavours to take such further practicable steps to notify the Defendants pursuant to the undertaking set out in Schedule 3

AND UPON any persons affected by this Order having the right to apply to vary to set aside the Order, pursuant to paragraph 15 below

AND UPON the Court having carefully considered the grounds for the Application, the evidence and any arguable defences that might be raised by the Defendants and being satisfied that the Claimants have established, on the evidence filed by the Claimants, that: (1) the Claimants have a good cause of action in relation to each of the Sites and the Access Roads, in respect of which they are likely to succeed at trial pursuant to section 12(3) of the Human Rights Act 1998; (2) the Claimants have complied with the duty of full and frank disclosure; (3) there is sufficient evidence of a real and imminent risk of tortious activity and real harm; (4) there is no realistic defence to the claim; (5) there is a compelling justification for the injunctions sought; and (6) damages would not be an adequate remedy

AND UPON the Claimants confirming that this Order is not intended to prohibit any lawful protest outside the Sites in so far as any such protest does not obstruct any of the pedestrian and vehicular entrances or exits to the Sites

AND UPON the Claimants giving and the Court accepting the undertakings set out in Schedule 3 to this Order

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

DEFINITIONS

1. “**The Sites**” means the land defined in Schedule 1 to this Order, the extent of which is shown for identification purposes coloured blue on each of the relevant plans appended to this Order in Schedule 2 (“**the Plans**”).
2. “**The Access Roads**” means the roads which provide direct access to each of the relevant Sites, the extent of which is shown for identification purposes in pink and/or orange on the Plans.
3. “**Warning Notices**” means notices in the form as set out in Schedule 5 to this Order (and warning of the existence and general nature of this Order, the consequences of breaching it, identifying a point of contact and contact details from which copies of the Order may

be requested and identifying the website address www.morrisons-corporate.com/injunction at which copies of this Order may be viewed and downloaded).

PERMISSION TO AMEND

4. The Claimants have permission to amend the claim form in order to amend the description of the Defendants and in relation to the absence of an access road to one of the sites.

INJUNCTION

5. This Order shall last until the return date, to be listed on 20 January 2025 at 2pm and shall operate with immediate effect until varied, discharged or extended by further order. At the hearing on 20 January 2025, the Court shall consider whether the Order should continue and, if appropriate, give case management directions for the progression of the claim. The Defendants and any person affected by the Order is entitled to attend the return date hearing and make representations as to the matters before the court on that date.
6. The Defendants and each of them must not do any of the acts listed in paragraph 7 of this Order.
7. The acts referred to in paragraph 6 of this Order are:
 - a. entering, occupying or remaining upon any part of the Sites without the consent of the Claimants in connection with agricultural protests;
 - b. creating or causing blockades, obstructions of traffic and/or otherwise impeding, preventing or interfering with the passage by the Claimants its agents, servants, employees, licensees, invitees to, from, with or without vehicles, including tractors or other agricultural vehicles and equipment, over and across the Access Roads in connection with agricultural protests.

SERVICE

8. Pursuant to CPR 6.15, 6.27, and r. 81.4(2)(c) and (d), service of the amended Claim Form, the Application, and Witness Statements (with the names of the witnesses and

addresses removed) with their exhibits (“**the Claim Documents**”) shall be validly effected by:

- a. Uploading copies of the Claim Documents to the following website:

 - b. Sending an email to the email addresses listed in Schedule 4 to this Order stating that a claim has been brought and an application made, and that the Claim Documents can be found at the website referred to above.
 - c. Affixing the relevant Warning Notice at those locations marked with an “X” on the Plans setting out where the Claim Documents can be found and obtained in hard copy.
9. Pursuant to CPR 6.27, and r. 81.4(2)(c) and (d), service of the Order shall be validly effected on the Defendants by:
- a. Producing that a copy of the Order is uploaded to the following website:
www.morrisonsoncorporate.com/injunction
 - b. Sending an email to the email addresses listed in Schedule 4 to this Order attaching a copy of this Order.
 - c. Affixing a copy of the Order and the Plan applicable to the relevant Site in A4 size in a clear plastic envelope at those locations marked with an “X” on the Plans.
10. The taking of such steps set out at paragraph 8 and 9 shall be good and sufficient service of this Order and of the Claim Documents upon the Defendants and each of them.
11. Pursuant to CPR 6.15(4)(b) and 6.27, the deemed date of service of the Claim Documents shall be the date shown on the relevant certificate of service on completion of the steps described at paragraph 8. The step described at paragraph 8(c) will be completed when those documents are first affixed regardless of whether they are subsequently removed.
12. Pursuant to CPR 6.15(4)(b) and 6.27, the deemed date of service of this Order shall be the date shown on the relevant certificate of service on completion of the steps described

at paragraph 9. The step described at paragraphs 9(c) will be completed when those documents are first affixed regardless of whether they are subsequently removed.

13. The Court will provide sealed copies of this Order to the Claimants' solicitors for service (whose details are set out below).

FURTHER DIRECTIONS

14. Service on the Defendants of any further applications or documents in the proceedings by the Claimants shall be validly effected by carrying out each of the steps in paragraphs 8(a) and 8(b). Pursuant to CPR 6.15(4)(b) and 6.27, the deemed date of service of future documents shall be the date shown on the relevant certificate of service on completion of the steps described at paragraph 8(a) and (b).
15. Any person affected by this Order may apply to the Court at any time to vary or discharge it or so much of it as affects that person. If any evidence is to be relied upon in support of the application the substance of it must be communicated in writing to the Claimants' solicitors in advance of the hearing.
16. Any person applying to vary or discharge this Order must provide their full name, address and address for service.
17. No acknowledgment of service, admission or defence is required by any party until further so ordered.
18. Costs are reserved.

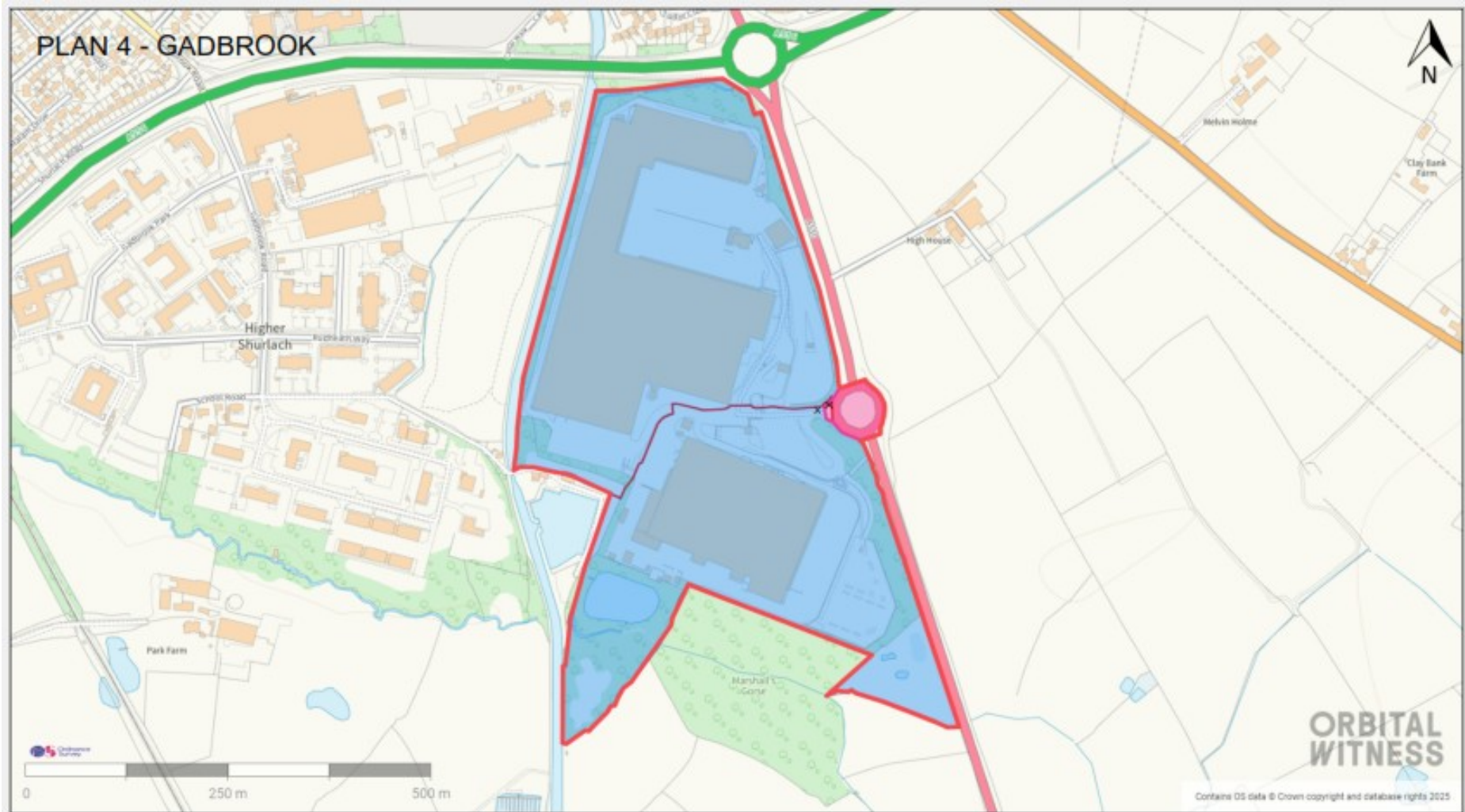


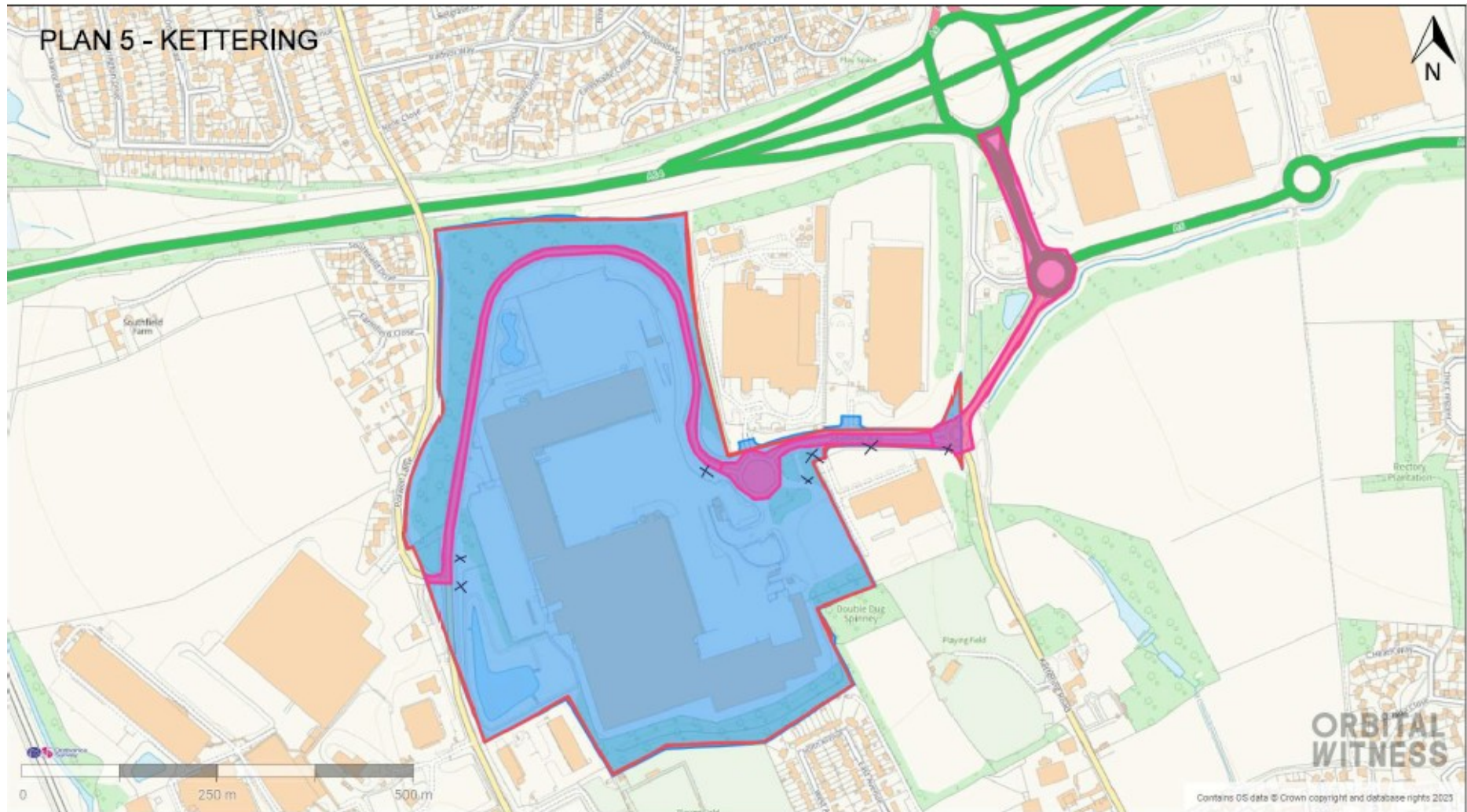




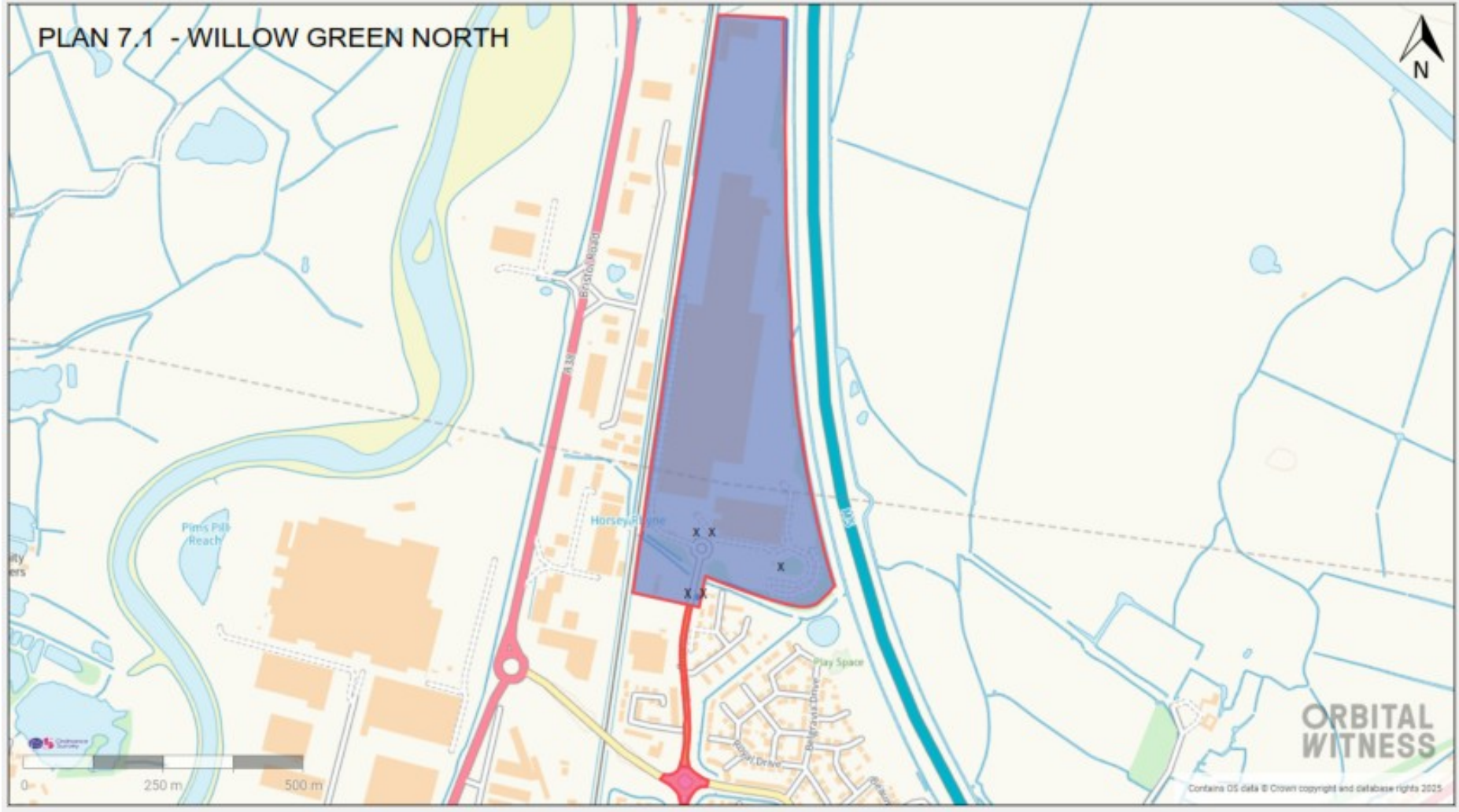


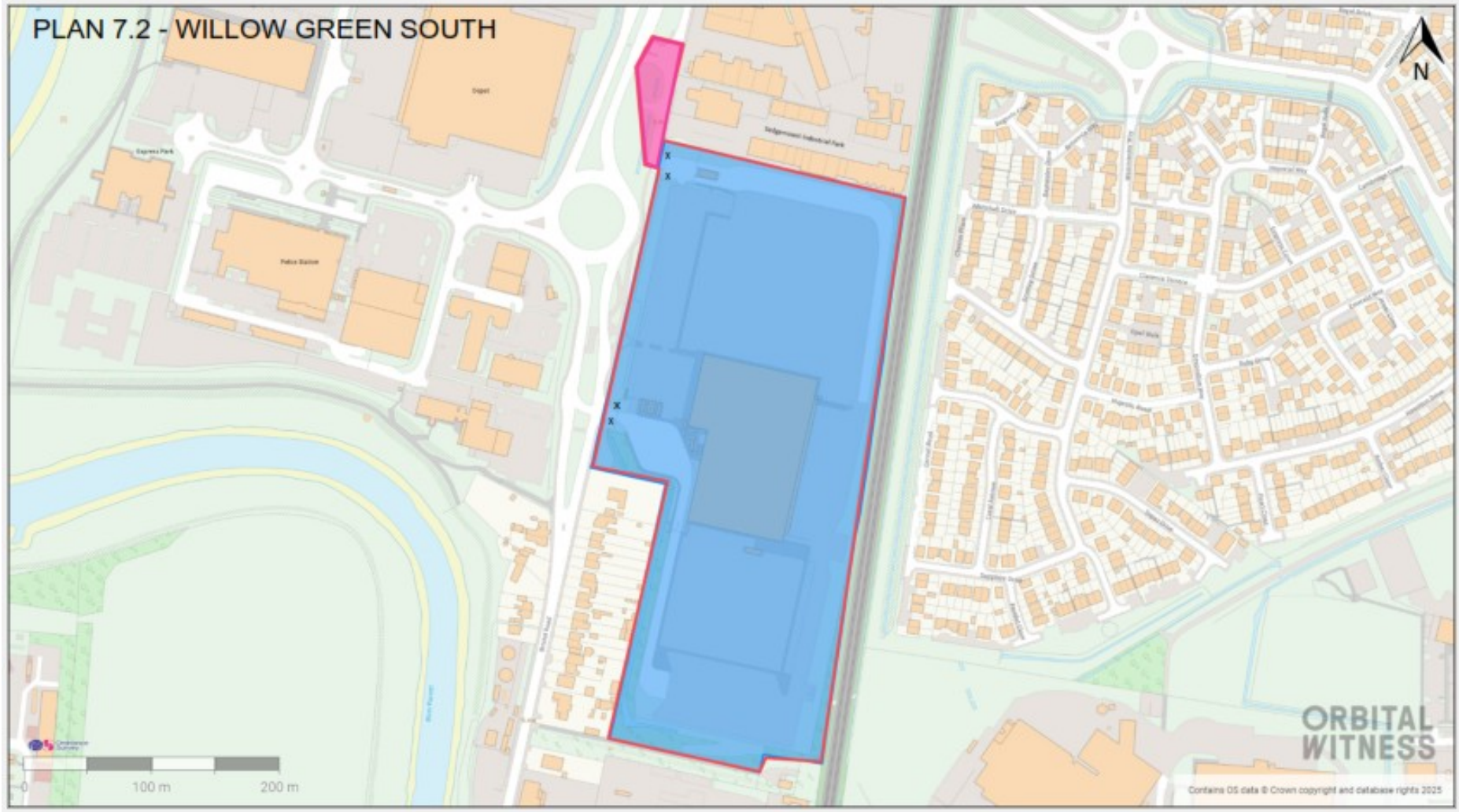


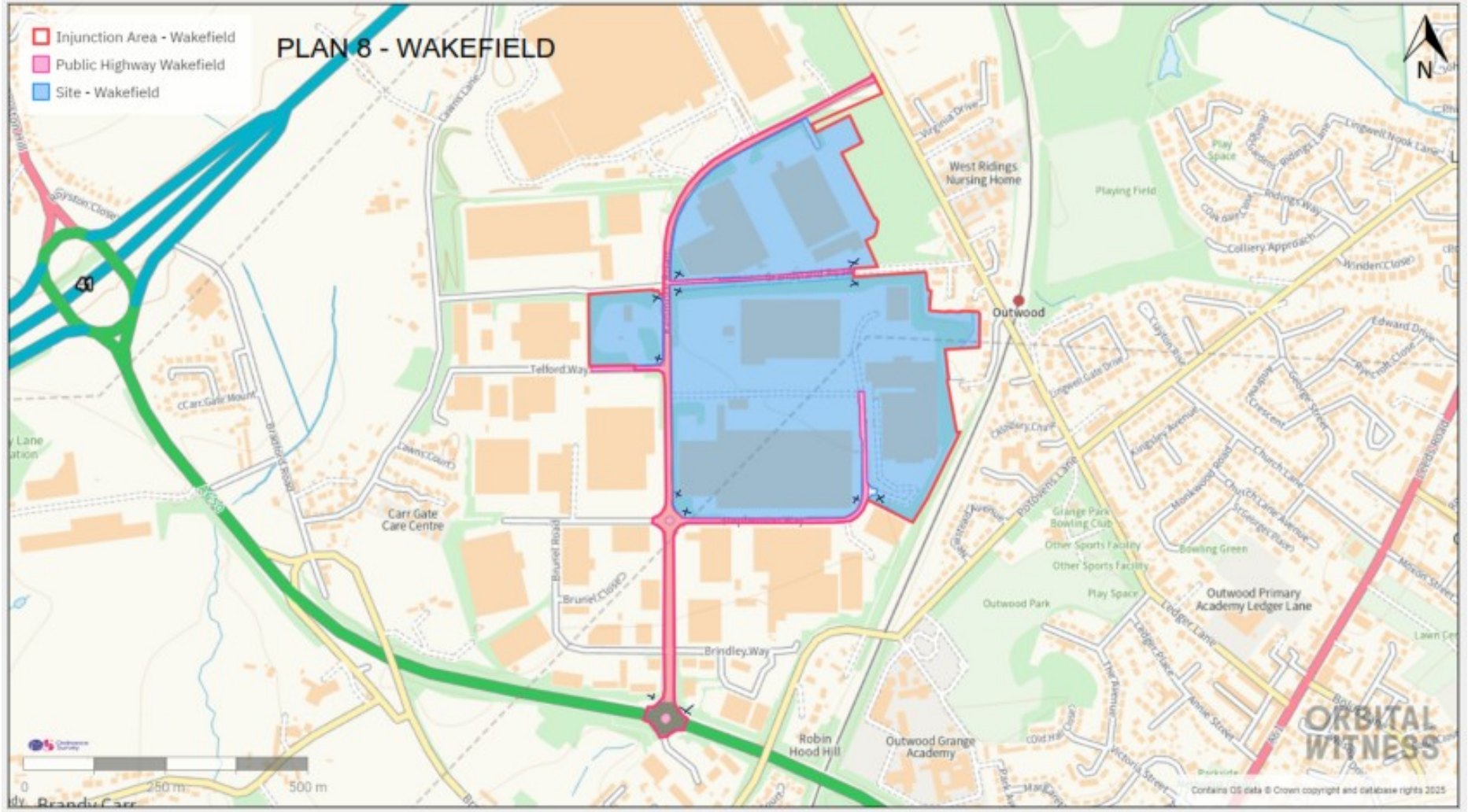












SCHEDULE 3 - UNDERTAKINGS GIVEN BY THE CLAIMANTS

I am writing to address the civil injunction and raise some key concerns as a director of Agri Web Media Ltd. For context, Agri Web Media Ltd is an advertising sales company that operates platforms including *The Farming Forum*, *Direct Driller Magazine*, and *Tech Farmer Magazine*.

Having reviewed some of the documents available, I want to clarify that Agri Web Media has had no involvement in the organisation or execution of the protest at the Morrisons distribution centre. Furthermore, we have no commercial relationship with Farmers To Action.

As such, we are uncertain why our company platform was mentioned in the initial claim and subsequent arguments. While we have supported other events related to changes in government Inheritance Tax (IHT) rules, this connection is entirely unrelated to the matters at hand. We do not believe that such subject overlap justifies our inclusion in court documentation concerning the blockage of distribution centres.

Additionally, I would like to address the use of the terms "advertising," "advertise," and "advertisement" within the documents. These terms could suggest that we were paid to promote specific activities, which is not the case. While we do carry paid advertising for corporate clients in the agricultural supply chain - serving approximately one million digital adverts daily - I can confirm that no advertising space was supplied for free or connected to the protest.

We are concerned that the inclusion of The Farming Forum (part of Agri Web Media Ltd) in these documents has the potential to cause reputational damage. As a company operating within the agricultural sector, with clients including Asda, Sainsbury's, and Waitrose, we take our reputation very seriously. It's worth noting that Morrisons, are also a potential client, given their existing advertising spend within agricultural media.

Therefore, we respectfully request that in any future documentation submitted to the court, the potential for reputational damage to our business is carefully considered. We kindly ask that any references to Agri Web Media Ltd or The Farming Forum are reviewed for accuracy, and appropriate wording is used to avoid any undue harm to our standing in the industry.


