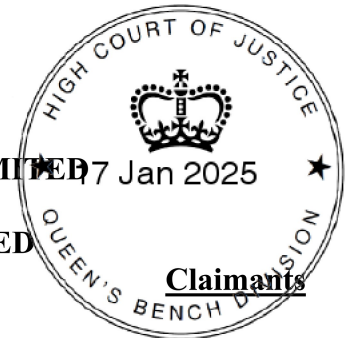

AND UPON the Claimants undertaking to the Court hereafter to use its best endeavours to take such further practicable steps to notify the Defendants pursuant to the undertaking set out in Schedule 3

AND UPON any persons affected by this Order having the right to apply to vary to set aside the Order, pursuant to paragraph 15 below

AND UPON the Court having carefully considered the grounds for the Application, the evidence and any arguable defences that might be raised by the Defendants and being satisfied that the Claimants have established, on the evidence filed by the Claimants, that: (1) the Claimants have a good cause of action in relation to each of the Sites and the Access Roads, in respect of which they are likely to succeed at trial pursuant to section 12(3) of the Human Rights Act 1998; (2) the Claimants have complied with the duty of full and frank disclosure; (3) there is sufficient evidence of a real and imminent risk of tortious activity and real harm; (4) there is no realistic defence to the claim; (5) there is a compelling justification for the injunctions sought; and (6) damages would not be an adequate remedy

AND UPON the Claimants confirming that this Order is not intended to prohibit any lawful protest outside the Sites in so far as any such protest does not obstruct any of the pedestrian and vehicular entrances or exits to the Sites

AND UPON the Claimants giving and the Court accepting the undertakings set out in Schedule 3 to this Order

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

DEFINITIONS

1. “**The Sites**” means the land defined in Schedule 1 to this Order, the extent of which is shown for identification purposes coloured blue on each of the relevant plans appended to this Order in Schedule 2 (“**the Plans**”).
2. “**The Access Roads**” means the roads which provide direct access to each of the relevant Sites, the extent of which is shown for identification purposes in pink and/or orange on the Plans.
3. “**Warning Notices**” means notices in the form as set out in Schedule 5 to this Order (and warning of the existence and general nature of this Order, the consequences of breaching it, identifying a point of contact and contact details from which copies of the Order may

be requested and identifying the website address www.morrisons-corporate.com/injunction at which copies of this Order may be viewed and downloaded).

PERMISSION TO AMEND

4. The Claimants have permission to amend the claim form in order to amend the description of the Defendants and in relation to the absence of an access road to one of the sites.

INJUNCTION

5. This Order shall last until the return date, to be listed on 20 January 2025 at 2pm and shall operate with immediate effect until varied, discharged or extended by further order. At the hearing on 20 January 2025, the Court shall consider whether the Order should continue and, if appropriate, give case management directions for the progression of the claim. The Defendants and any person affected by the Order is entitled to attend the return date hearing and make representations as to the matters before the court on that date.
6. The Defendants and each of them must not do any of the acts listed in paragraph 7 of this Order.
7. The acts referred to in paragraph 6 of this Order are:
 - a. entering, occupying or remaining upon any part of the Sites without the consent of the Claimants in connection with agricultural protests;
 - b. creating or causing blockades, obstructions of traffic and/or otherwise impeding, preventing or interfering with the passage by the Claimants its agents, servants, employees, licensees, invitees to, from, with or without vehicles, including tractors or other agricultural vehicles and equipment, over and across the Access Roads in connection with agricultural protests.

SERVICE

8. Pursuant to CPR 6.15, 6.27, and r. 81.4(2)(c) and (d), service of the amended Claim Form, the Application, and Witness Statements (with the names of the witnesses and

addresses removed) with their exhibits (“**the Claim Documents**”) shall be validly effected by:

- a. Uploading copies of the Claim Documents to the following website:

 - b. Sending an email to the email addresses listed in Schedule 4 to this Order stating that a claim has been brought and an application made, and that the Claim Documents can be found at the website referred to above.
 - c. Affixing the relevant Warning Notice at those locations marked with an “X” on the Plans setting out where the Claim Documents can be found and obtained in hard copy.
9. Pursuant to CPR 6.27, and r. 81.4(2)(c) and (d), service of the Order shall be validly effected on the Defendants by:
- a. Producing that a copy of the Order is uploaded to the following website:
www.morrisonsoncorporate.com/injunction
 - b. Sending an email to the email addresses listed in Schedule 4 to this Order attaching a copy of this Order.
 - c. Affixing a copy of the Order and the Plan applicable to the relevant Site in A4 size in a clear plastic envelope at those locations marked with an “X” on the Plans.
10. The taking of such steps set out at paragraph 8 and 9 shall be good and sufficient service of this Order and of the Claim Documents upon the Defendants and each of them.
11. Pursuant to CPR 6.15(4)(b) and 6.27, the deemed date of service of the Claim Documents shall be the date shown on the relevant certificate of service on completion of the steps described at paragraph 8. The step described at paragraph 8(c) will be completed when those documents are first affixed regardless of whether they are subsequently removed.
12. Pursuant to CPR 6.15(4)(b) and 6.27, the deemed date of service of this Order shall be the date shown on the relevant certificate of service on completion of the steps described

at paragraph 9. The step described at paragraphs 9(c) will be completed when those documents are first affixed regardless of whether they are subsequently removed.

13. The Court will provide sealed copies of this Order to the Claimants' solicitors for service (whose details are set out below).

FURTHER DIRECTIONS

14. Service on the Defendants of any further applications or documents in the proceedings by the Claimants shall be validly effected by carrying out each of the steps in paragraphs 8(a) and 8(b). Pursuant to CPR 6.15(4)(b) and 6.27, the deemed date of service of future documents shall be the date shown on the relevant certificate of service on completion of the steps described at paragraph 8(a) and (b).
15. Any person affected by this Order may apply to the Court at any time to vary or discharge it or so much of it as affects that person. If any evidence is to be relied upon in support of the application the substance of it must be communicated in writing to the Claimants' solicitors in advance of the hearing.
16. Any person applying to vary or discharge this Order must provide their full name, address and address for service.
17. No acknowledgment of service, admission or defence is required by any party until further so ordered.
18. Costs are reserved.

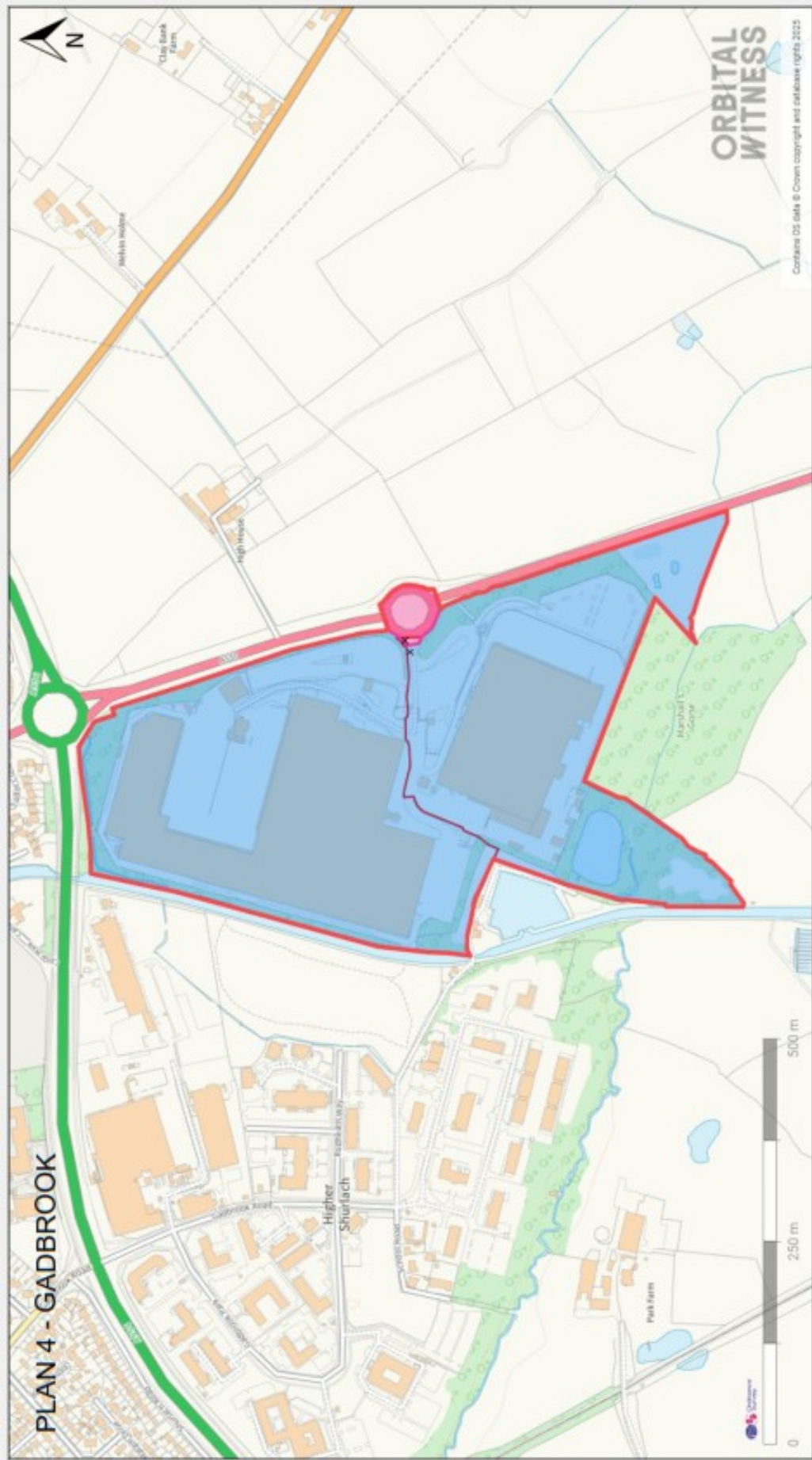


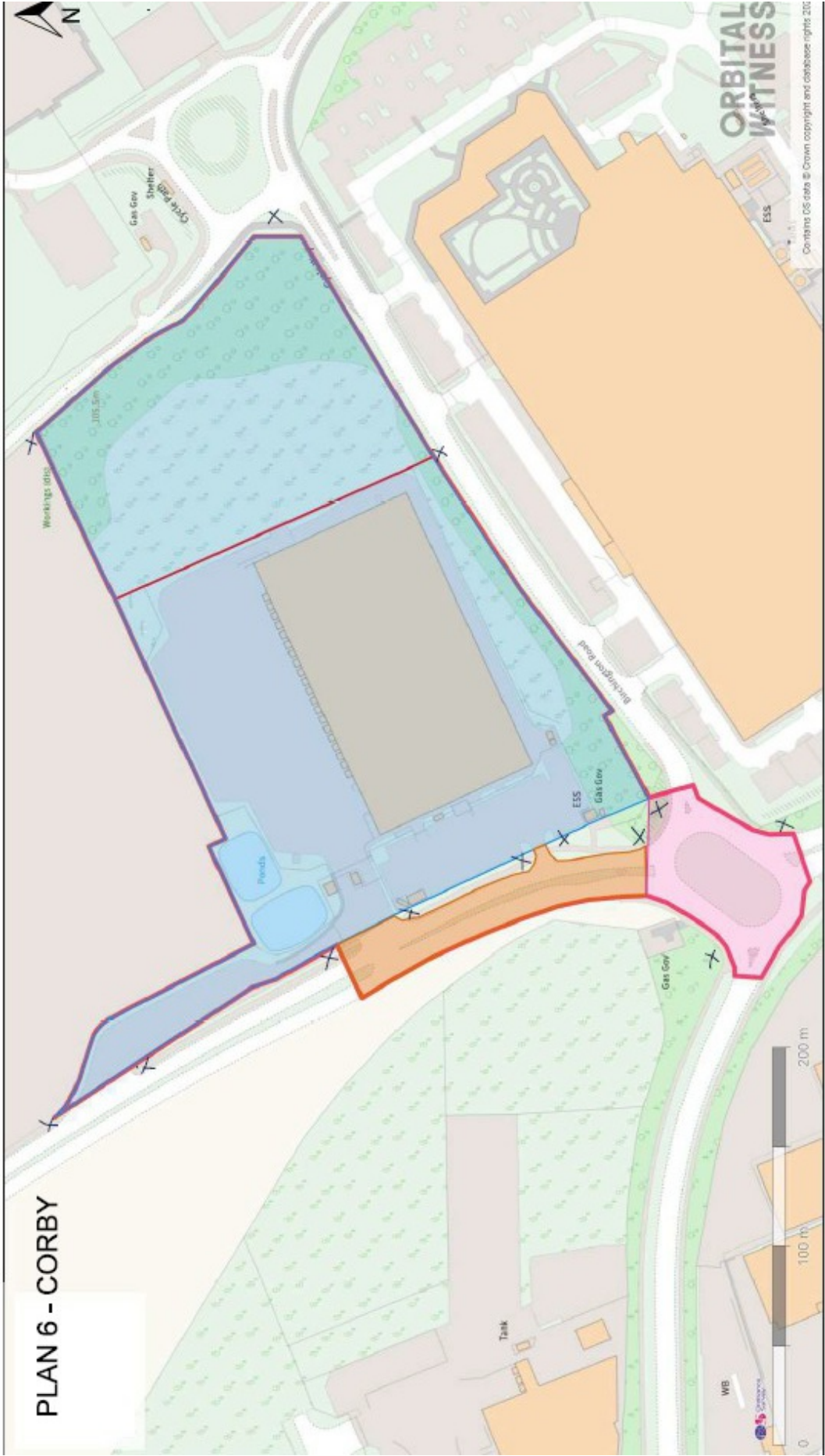


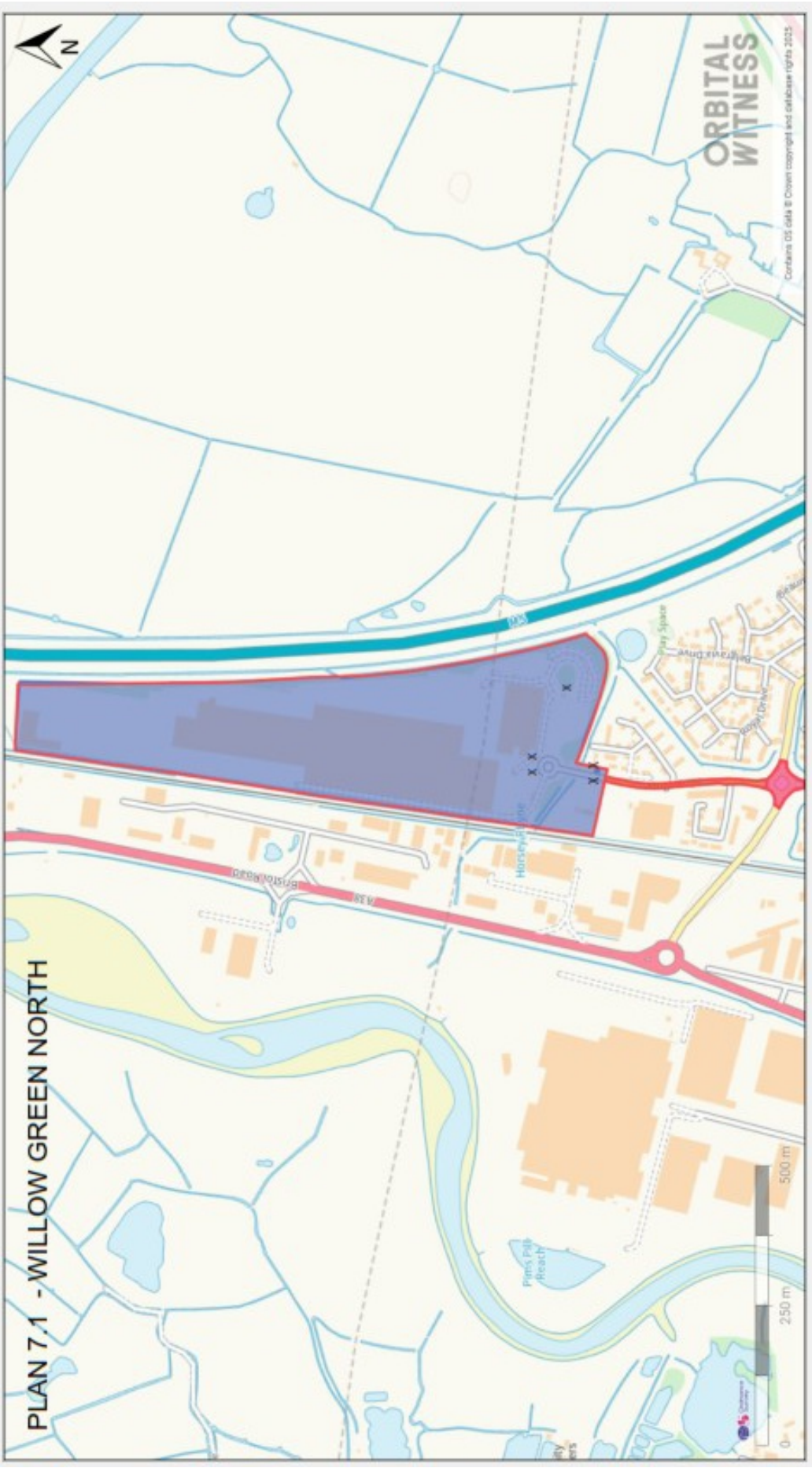


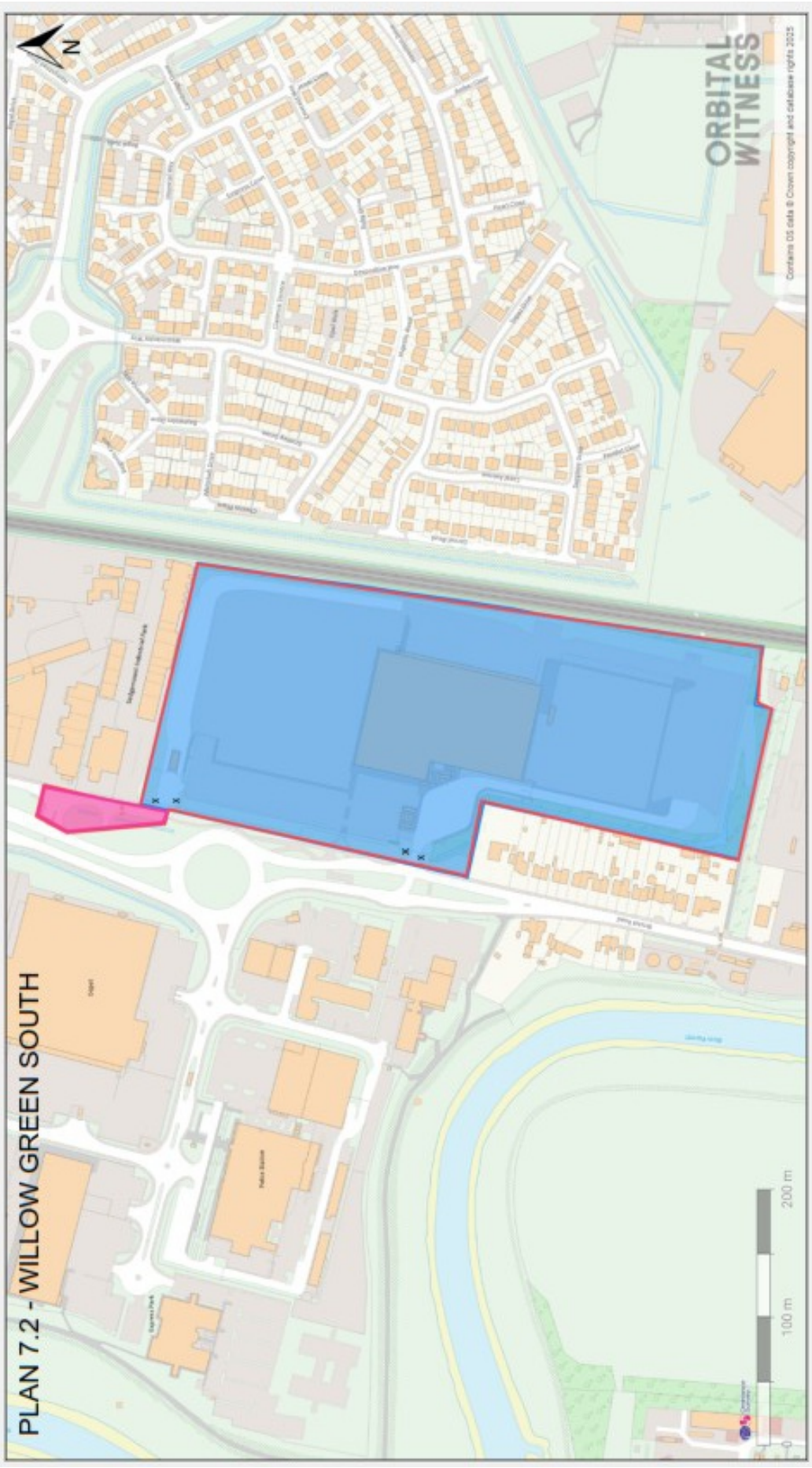




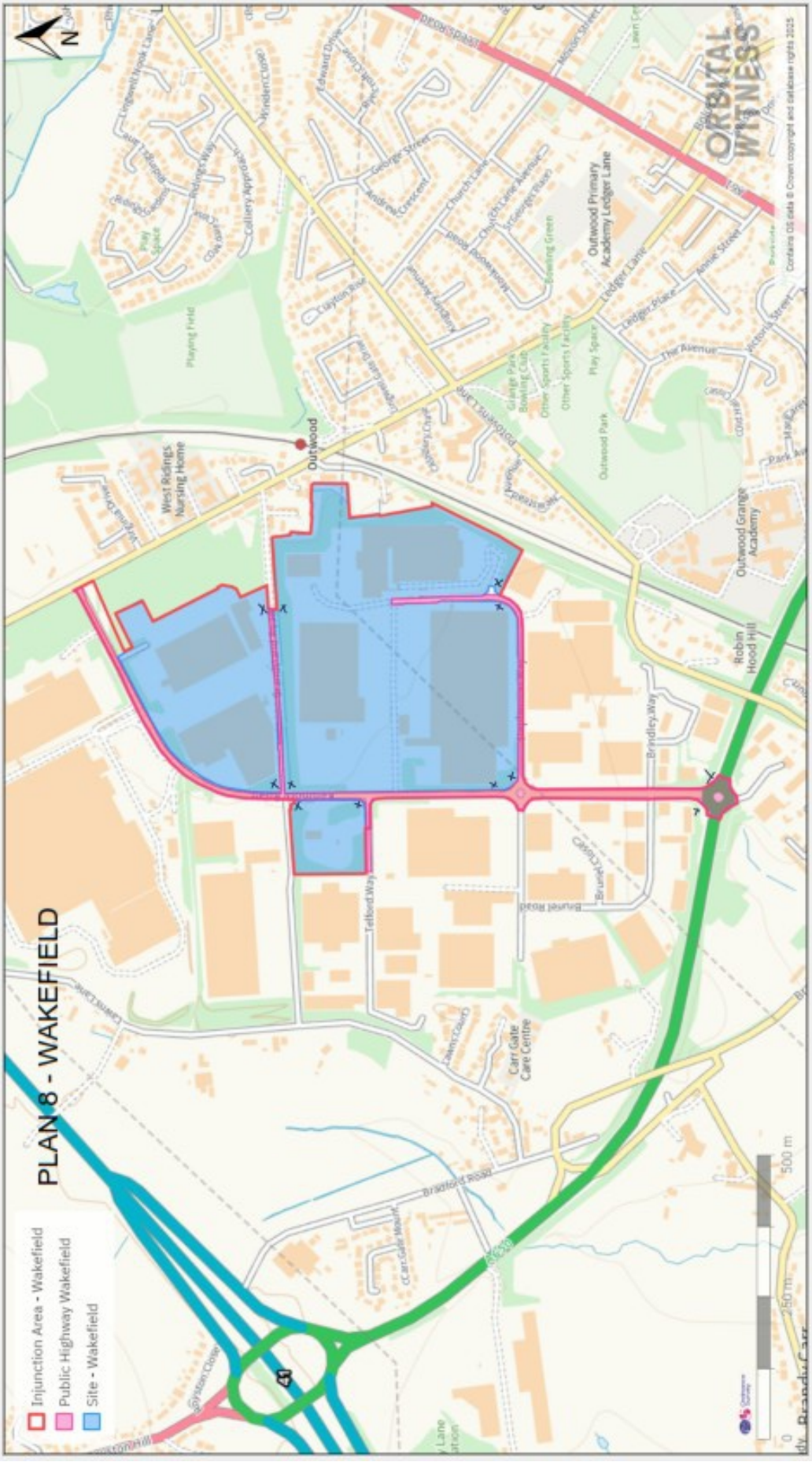








PLAN 7.2 - WILLOW GREEN SOUTH

AND UPON the Court having carefully considered the grounds for the Application, the evidence and any arguable defences that might be raised by the Defendants and being satisfied

that the Claimants have established, on the evidence filed by the Claimants, that: (1) the Claimants have a good cause of action in relation to each of the Distribution Centres and the Access Roads, in respect of which they are likely to succeed at trial pursuant to section 12(3) of the Human Rights Act 1998; (2) the Claimants have complied with the duty of full and frank disclosure; (3) there is sufficient evidence of a real and imminent risk of tortious activity and real harm; (4) there is no realistic defence to the claim; (5) there is a compelling justification for the injunctions sought; and (6) damages would not be an adequate remedy

AND UPON the Court being satisfied that the relevant procedural requirements for the grant of injunctions against “Persons Unknown” have been established by the Claimants on the evidence and that the terms of the Order are clear and appropriate and, in the circumstances, that it is just and convenient to grant the injunctions sought

AND UPON the Claimants confirming that this order is not intended to prohibit any lawful protest outside the Distribution Centres in so far as any such protest does not obstruct any of the pedestrian and vehicular entrances or exits to the Distribution Centres

AND UPON the Claimants giving and the Court accepting the undertakings set out in Schedule 3 to this order

AND in replacement of the injunctions granted by the Collins Rice J Order and continued by the First Fordham J Order, but with the intention that the provisions for alternative service set out in paragraphs 8-12 and 14 of the Collins Rice J Order shall remain unaffected and in force

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

DEFINITIONS

1. “**The Distribution Centres**” means the land defined in Schedule 1 to this order, the extent of which is shown for identification purposes coloured blue on each of the relevant plans appended to this order in Schedule 2 (“**the Plans**”).
2. “**The Access Roads**” means the roads which provide direct access to each of the relevant Distribution Centres, the extent of which is shown for identification purposes in pink and/or orange on the Plans.

3. “**Warning Notices**” means notices in the form as set out in Schedule 5 to this order (and warning of the existence and general nature of this order, the consequences of breaching it, identifying a point of contact and contact details from which copies of the order may be requested and identifying the website address www.morrisons-corporate.com/injunction at which copies of this order may be viewed and downloaded).

PERMISSION TO AMEND

4. The Claimants have permission to re-amend the claim form in order to re-amend the description of the Defendants by substituting the reference to “Sites” for “Distribution Centres” and correcting the reference to “regional distribution centres” in paragraph 3 of the details of claim.

INJUNCTION

5. Subject to paragraph 8 below, this order shall operate with immediate effect until varied, discharged or extended by further order.
6. The Defendants and each of them must not do any of the acts listed in paragraph 7 of this order.
7. The acts referred to in paragraph 6 of this order are:
 - a. entering, occupying or remaining upon any part of the Distribution Centres without the consent of the Claimants in connection with agricultural protests;
 - b. creating or causing blockades, obstructions of traffic and/or otherwise impeding, preventing or interfering with the passage by the Claimants, its agents, servants, employees, licensees, invitees to, from, with or without vehicles, including tractors or other agricultural vehicles and equipment, over and across the Access Roads in connection with agricultural protests.
8. There is to be a further return date of the Application, listed for 29 January 2025 at 12pm, with a time estimate of three and a half hours at which the Court will consider whether the injunctions granted by this order shall continue for a further period and, if appropriate, give case management directions for the progression of the claim

FURTHER DIRECTIONS

9. The Defendants and any persons affected by this order who wish to attend the return date hearing and make representations to the Court shall provide their written representations and any evidence which is to be relied upon by them at the hearing of the return date to the Claimants' solicitors by no later than 4pm on 24 January 2025.
10. No acknowledgment of service, admission or defence is required by any party until further so ordered.
11. Costs are reserved.

Dedicated telesales service launched for customers who can't visit stores

- Customers can order a delivery to their doorstep from a list of 47 essential items
- Vulnerable customers offered assistance with extra staff that 'love to help'

Morrisons is today announcing a new dedicated telesales shopping service aimed specifically at helping to ensure vulnerable and elderly people can get the groceries they need.

Customers who wish to place an order should phone 0345 611 6111 and select option five.

It is one of a number of measures that are being introduced in response to the Coronavirus pandemic to ensure that no customer gets left behind. Morrisons has received many calls from customers who are self isolating, elderly, vulnerable and not able to visit a shop. Some have little food in their store cupboard and are worried about how they will stock up when demand for home deliveries has been high. Some have never used online ordering.

These customers will be able to place orders with Morrisons over the phone and the delivery will be made the following day by a store colleague from their local store, often the store's Community Champion, who is tasked with helping the community.

They can:

- Choose from a 'takeaway' menu of 47 essential groceries with options including milk, butter, eggs, potatoes, pasta, bananas, cornflakes and flour
- Pay for delivery on their doorstep via a mobile chip and pin device
- Refuse an item on delivery should they wish to do so but every effort will be made to match the customers' specific preferences.

David Potts, Morrisons Chief Executive said: "We are playing our full part in feeding the nation and ensuring those that are most in need can receive a delivery from a familiar face at Morrisons. This new telephone service will ensure that more people who can't leave their home to go shopping will be able to get a delivery."

Additionally, the Morrisons Community Champions will be identifying customers who need support and offering it on a postcard through their door. Customers will be able to ring them directly if they need their shopping delivered.

Those vulnerable and elderly customers who do come to stores will also be offered a helping hand from colleagues wearing 'love to help' t-shirts.

To help support this new service, Morrisons has invested in a van for every one of its 494 stores so that colleagues can drop the shopping off on a customer's doorstep.

Morrisons is already helping elderly and vulnerable people by expanding its home delivery service and making more slots available to customers both through Morrisons.com and the Morrisons Store on Amazon Prime Now. It is also rolling out rolling out food boxes and has partnered up with Deliveroo to allow customers to order from a range of essentials delivered to their door by a Deliveroo rider on the same day.
